STOP Violence Against Women Formula Grant Program**

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN UPDATES

The 2005 New Mexico STOP Violence Against Women Implementation Team recommended updates to the 2003 three-year plan based on current statewide needs.

The following updates will be incorporated into the 2003 New Mexico three-year implementation plan.

1. The Intimate Partner Violence Death Review Team project will expand the project to Indian country to gain support for the case review process and will provide technical assistance to tribes to support them to do this work.
2. A crimes against women law enforcement training conference will be developed and implemented for attendees that are state and tribal leaders and decision-makers in the law enforcement field.
3. A regional court project will be developed and implemented that promotes victim safety, effective access to courts and offender accountability.
4. Effective July 1, 2005, the state of New Mexico will provide the New Mexico Judicial Education Center with funds to provide sexual violence training for state and tribal court judges. Therefore, STOP Grant funds will be used exclusively to provide judicial education on sexual violence.
5. A Sexual Assault Manual for judges will be developed that is based on the Michigan Sexual Assault Benchbook.
6. A multidisciplinary conference on Human Trafficking will be developed and implemented to provide statewide awareness of the issue. An important outcome will be the development of a statewide Human Trafficking task force.
7. To increase SANE access in rural areas, a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner preceptor program will be developed and implemented in conjunction with the University of New Mexico, to enable nurses to meet the SANE pelvic examination requirement within a short period of time.
8. A two-day tribal law enforcement conference will provide information and techniques on responding to domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking in Indian country. Jurisdictional issues regarding full faith and credit and conditions of release will also be addressed.
