## SANDOVAL COUNTY INDIGENT PROGRAM 867-7613

To qualify, you must be a resident of Sandoval County for at least three months before incurring the expenses, bills must total \$100 or more, and income guidelines must be met.

The Sandoval County Indigent Fund can provide assistance with hospital, ambulance, substance abuse, mental health, and prenatal care bills. Up to 90 percent of the charges or \$10,000, whichever is lower, may qualify for coverage. The maximum certified for ambulance service is \$500.00 or 90 percent of billed charges, whichever is less, with higher amounts allowed for air-ambulance service. The program does not provide financial assistance with doctor or dental bills. The program also can provide up to \$600 per year for prescriptions for qualified residents.

Applications must be submitted within 90 days of the billing date in order to be considered by the County Indigent Board.
