

New Mexico VINE is an automated service that allows you to track an offender's custody status over the phone or Internet. You can register to be notified by phone, text and/or email if an offender is released, transferred, or escapes.

Write down the following information, remove this panel, and keep it in a safe place:

Offender Name

Offender/Booking Number

Your four-digit PIN



- If you feel you are in danger, call 911 immediately.
- VINE is confidential. The offender will not know you are registered with this service.
- New Mexico VINE only provides information on offenders in custody in New Mexico.
- Since VINE calls automatically when an offender's custody status changes, you may get a call from VINE in the middle of the night.
- Write down your PIN and keep it in a safe place.
 For safety reasons, do not share this information with others.
- If you do not answer a notification call, VINE will leave a message and will continue calling back until you enter your PIN or until up to 24 hours have passed.
- Do not register a phone number that rings to a switchboard.
- You can register multiple phone numbers and email addresses for notifications.
- If you forget your PIN, call the toll-free number and press zero. You will be transferred to an operator who can help you reset your PIN or cancel notification.
- Operators are available 24 hours a day, seven days a week to assist you.

Information

Call 1-877-551-8463 or visit www.vinelink.com and follow the instructions to receive information about an offender's custody status.

Registration

You can register to receive notifications related to custody status information. You must register separately for each type of notification.

If registering a phone number, you will be asked to create a four-digit personal identification number (PIN) that will be used to confirm that the call or text was received. Make sure your PIN is easy to remember.

To register your email address, either call the New Mexico VINE and press zero to speak with an operator or visit www.vinelink.com. Email notifications do not require a PIN.

Notification

Custody Status

You will be notified about the following events:

- Release
- Death
- Transfer
- Escape

When VINE calls, listen to the message, then enter your PIN followed by the pound (#) key when asked. Entering the PIN lets the service know that you received the message and will stop the current notification call.
